

GM Johnson Maps Catalogue Notes

GM Johnson Catalogue describes products that:

- a) We distribute / sell to wholesalers and consumers.
- b) We have authored (we are the cartographers)

Title column: Map name on cover

State column: Describe state, province and country abbreviations.

Type column: Describe each category

Map – standard map (usually folded)

Atlas – collection of maps in a book format

Map Book – GM Johnson brand for an atlas

Pearl – laminated or coated folded map (GM Johnson brand)

Slicker – laminated folded map (AMC brand)

Quick – laminated folded map (Global Graphics brand)

Subtype column: Description of each map type

Street – shows city streets in detail (large scale)

State – shows highways, major connecting roads, has city enlargements, mileage distances, recreation area table, city population symbols

Recreation – emphasis is on outdoor recreation (regional map)

Road – can be a derivative of a state or regional map showing highways and major roads

Regional – shows most roads with an emphasis on points of interest and may include descriptive text of places.

Wall – large format map usually laminated (print on demand)

City – urban area of a city, does not show much rural area

Topo – topographical map showing elevation either using contours or shaded relief.

County – a map showing a unique county with city enlargements, scale of map is usually 1-inch equal 1 mile.

UPC column: Bar code number for general retail. Our policy is, if the retail price changes we change the UPC.

ISBN column: Bar code number for bookstores and libraries. Our policy is, if we have a new edition of a map we change the ISBN.

Retail: Price of the printed map.

Scale column: The scale of the printed map. For example:

32k are 1:32000 or 1 inch equals approx. 0.5 mile;

192k is 1:192000 or 1 inch equals approx. 3 miles;

1.25m is 1:1250000 or 1 inch equals approx. 20 miles.

Size Page column: Describe physical size of printed map in inches. It could also describe the number of pages.

Fin Size column: Describe the finished size of the product in inches. Once the map has been folded or put in a book.

Publisher column: Abbreviations for this column are as follows:

Author column: Same abbreviations as the Publisher column.

Copyright column: The copyright year of the printed map.

Status column: Descriptions for this column are as follows:

Digital – Only available as downloadable computer map, has not been printed.

Out of print - No longer available as a printed map, product is still available in a computer format for downloading.

Month and year - The schedule month and year the printed map will be available.

Hold - Map release date has been delayed. A number of factors could contribute to this status.

Working - Map is being developed, but no schedule date has been confirmed for release.

New edition - A new edition of a current product is about to be released.

If using the excel spreadsheet file there are 4 hidden columns that you can un-hide to view.

The following columns are hidden:

O - ISBN cover JPG (The file name of our covers by ISBN number)

P - Cover String (The generated string for use in cover image names)

R - Cover Name (The full generated filename for our cover images)
